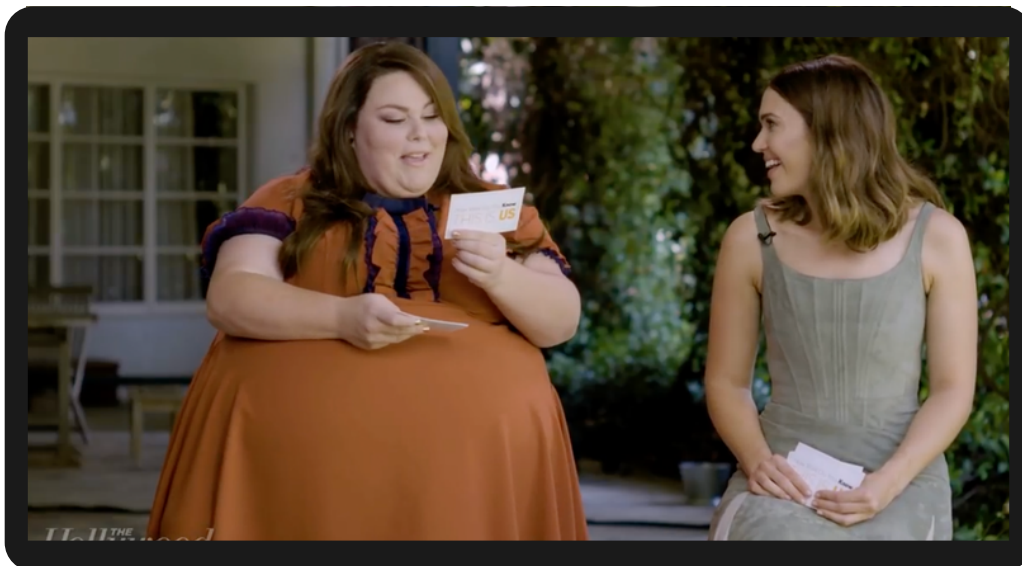

Even when we went back to the United States paperwork was not easy. My mom still had her job as a nurse thankfully because in Bolivia the paperwork took about six months before myself and my brother could leave the country. So, my dad had to quit his job, he was a teacher, so he decided to quit teaching and move down to Bolivia to be with us for six months while my mom would fly back and forth because she still had her job as a nurse in Ohio. And so, finally at six months my parents were allowed to take us back to the United States and then I believe a year later is when the paperwork was finally finalized. And so that's how we got to the United States and we lived in Ohio for about six years and after six years my parents decided we were gonna move to Madrid, Spain. So, we moved to Spain when I was six and I knew no Spanish at all and it was very difficult to learn the language. Well, not so much to learn the language but very difficult to acclimate to a different culture and my parents put my brothers and I first into a Spanish school so we could learn Spanish and we learnt in about... I believe a year and a half or so. Most like... you know... everything that we needed to know to be able to communicate.
